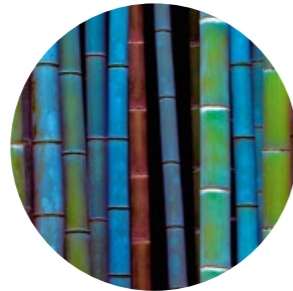

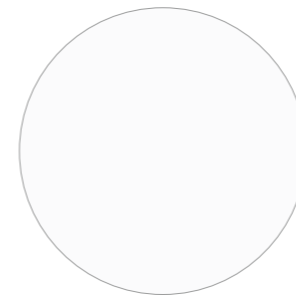
Get to know the Classic Collection – and be inspired.

- Surfaces can be cleaned with all common household cleaning products with the exception of those containing scouring agents.

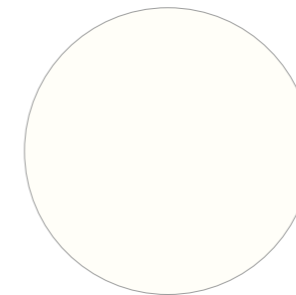
DISCREET COLOURS

Refined reticence.

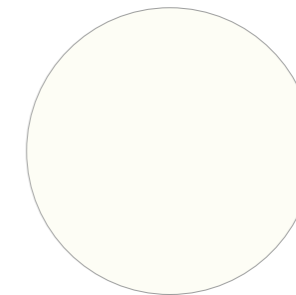

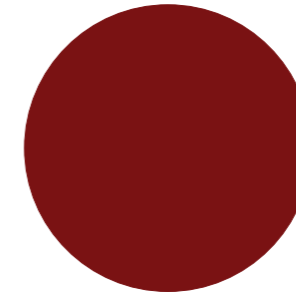
STRONG COLOURS

Setting a confident tone.

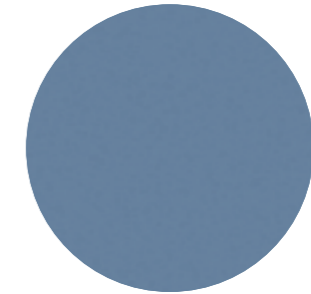

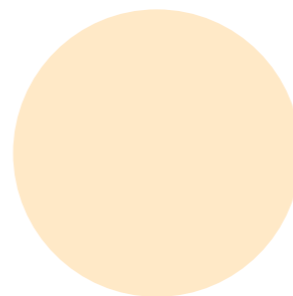

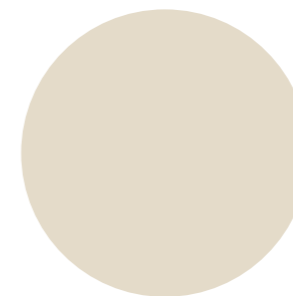
WARM NATURAL SHADES

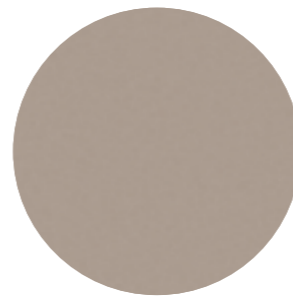

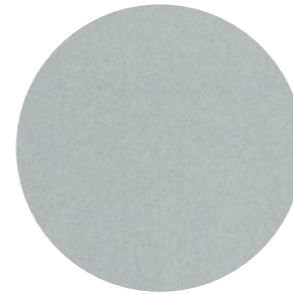
